**\*\*CCCCSD Grading System for Grades 9-12:**

The high school uses a weighted numerical grading system. In calculating GPA, ten points are added to a student's average in any course designated as an incentive course in the course description guide. (Ex: Pre-AP Courses, AP Courses and Dual Credit Courses)

In order to obtain automatic admission to a Texas university, a student must rank in the top 10 percent of their graduating class (top 8 percent for the University of Texas at Austin) **and** graduate with a distinguished level of achievement.
