How it Works:

- Call or text the following hotline number(s) according to your school

Ozona Elementary 325-267-6778
Ozona Middle School 325-455-1202
Ozona High School 325-455-1205

- Students and parents can send a text message, or call and leave a voice message
- Their Caller ID is masked, making their report anonymous
- The messages are forwarded to one or more school officials designated to monitor for reports
- The monitors have the ability to reply to text messages and start a two-way anonymous chat
- The goal is to engage the student to begin a dialog and start a resolution process

Our goal is to ensure that each student feels comfortable coming forward, either face-to-face or anonymously. Encourage your student to use all the services that are offered by CCCCS to help resolve any issues that they may face. We are here to help, but we can't help if we don't know.

As a parent, you are also welcome to report issues. Anything that you think we should know to ensure the health and safety of our students should be reported.
